## Friends of the Ferndale Library CAKE OFF RULES

Cake Off Date: Saturday, October 1, 2022 Registration Deadline: Wednesday, September 28 2022

- The CAKE OFF will take place during the Friends of the Ferndale Library 2022 Member Appreciation Celebration on Saturday, October 1st, from 2:00-4:00PM in the library courtyard. All CAKE OFF contestants will receive a complimentary one-year Friends membership and invitation to the member appreciation celebration for themselves and members of their households. All others who wish to attend are invited to become members by enrolling online at <u>www.ferndalefriends.org</u> or at the library. Attendees will have the opportunity to taste a variety of cake submissions, vote for their favorites, and enjoy a day of family fun.
- 2. Contestants must present their finished cakes to the library courtyard at 1:30PM.
- 3. At least two CAKE OFF prizes will be awarded: one for Judges' Choice winner and one for People's Choice winner. The Judges' Choice winner will be chosen by a panel of "celebrity" judges. The People's Choice winner will be determined by attendees' votes.
- 4. Contestants may only enter one cake.
- 5. Cakes may be any size and number of tiers, but be advised, the cake size will determine the number of attendees who can taste and judge the cake. (See Rule 3, People's Choice)
- 6. For the purposes of this event, the Friends of the Ferndale Library are using a modified version of the Merriam-Webster definition of "cake" to mean: "a sweet baked food made from dough or thick batter and sliced into multiple servings." Therefore, cheesecakes, cupcakes, and petit-fours, for example, while delicious, will not qualify for the CAKE OFF.
- 7. Store bought cakes will not qualify, but semi-homemade (cake mixes, store bought components) are acceptable.
- 8. Cakes will be judged on taste, appearance, and creativity, up to five points for each category.
- 9. Cakes that accommodate specific diets (vegan, gluten free, no refined sugar, etc.) are encouraged. All bakers will submit an ingredient list to help attendees avoid allergens, etc.
